CITY OF LOGANVILLE Regular Council Meeting Minutes Thursday, December 9, 2021 6:30pm Council Chambers

The City of Loganville Mayor and Council met for their regular Council Meeting on Thursday, December 9, 2021 at 6:30pm in the Council Chambers. Mayor Rey Martinez and Council Members Jay Boland, Linda Dodd, Bill DuVall, Danny Ford, Anne Huntsinger and Lisa Newberry were all present.

Mayor Rey Martinez called the meeting to order at 6:36pm.

The invocation was given and the pledge to the flag was led.

Council Member Anne Huntsinger made a motion to amend the agenda to include discussion of a movie filming downtown. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Danny Ford made a motion to adopt the agenda with the amendment. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Linda Dodd made a motion to approve last month's minutes. Council Member Lisa Newberry seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Anne Huntsinger made a motion to approve last month's financial report. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Mayor Rey Martinez recognized Levi Barrelle as Mayor for a Day.

Police Chief Mike McHugh gave an update regarding the Annual Shop with a Hero.

Rick Jarvis was present and spoke on behalf of Waste Management. Waste Management has requested a price increase due to the increase cost of fuel, recycling and employment cost that have been brought on by the Covid-19 Pandemic. After discussion, Council Member Anne Huntsinger made a motion to approve an increase for residential pickup of \$2 per household and \$1 per additional can effective February 1, 2022. Council Member Jay Boland seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Anne Huntsinger made a motion to approve an 8% increase on commercial pickup effective March 1, 2022 provided staff receive hauler call training by January and provide a carryover list by January. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Anne Huntsinger explained that a company is interested in filming a movie downtown and would like to rent use of our parking lots, Town Green and Rock Gym. Council Member Anne Huntsinger made a motion to approve this request and proceed with developing an agreement between the City and the company that would not go against our ordinances. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Jay Boland made a motion to approve the purchase of AED's for the Police Department with the donated funds from the Back the Blue Car Show for \$10,230.88. Council Member Lisa Newberry seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

The Police Department congratulated SRO Dustin Peterson for being name SRO of the Month by the National Association of School Resource Officers for November and Officer Clint Kitchens as LPD Officer of the Year.

Council Member Bill DuVall made a motion to approve the repair to the Gwinnett Water Valve for \$16,144.05. Council Member Anne Huntsinger seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Danny Ford made a motion to approve a change in the retiree health insurance allowing employees who retire from the City by meeting the rule of 80 be allowed to continue their health insurance with the City contributing \$500 towards the premium and to establish a trust to fund the City's expense. Council Member Anne Huntsinger seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Anne Huntsinger made a motion to approve the NEGA Solid Waste Management Plan Resolution. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

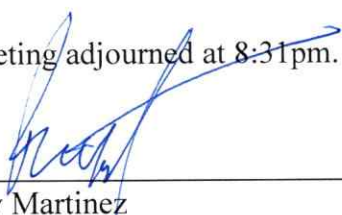

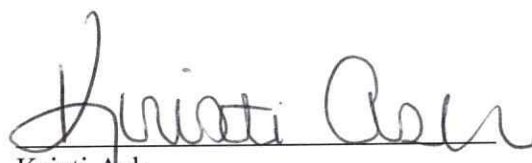
Council Member Jay Boland made a motion to go back into open session. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.
